

Download the Free TruHearing App Today

- **Step 1:** Go to the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play Store (Android) icon on your phone.
- Step 2: Type ,TruHearing App' into the search bar and select the app from the list.

Pairing the App with Your TruHearing Hearing Aids

Pairing with an iPhone

- **1 -** Open "Settings" app on the iPhone®, OR from the TruHearing app select "Bluetooth®" connection option.
- **2 -** In your phone settings: Select "General", then "Accessibility", then "MFi Hearing Devices" or "Hearing Devices"
- **3 -** Turn Bluetooth® on and pair the hearing aids when prompted; the names of your hearing aids will be in blue when successful.
- **4 -** Open TruHearing app and tap "Let's Go" to pair your hearing aids to the app.

Pairing with an Android

- **1 -** When pairing your hearing aids to an Android device, go directly into the TruHearing app (the phone's native Bluetooth® menu does not allow correct pairing).
- **2 -** Open TruHearing app and select "Bluetooth®" connection option.
- **3** Verify phone is on the list, tap "Next".
- **4 -** Restart the hearing aids and place them next to the phone. Tap "OK".
- **5** Tap the names of your hearing aids once they appear.
- **6** Tap "Let's Go" to pair your hearing aids to the app.
